Manage all the SMART Boards in your school using SMART's remote management.




Get to know your MX board



Turn on the display

Press the Power button \bigcirc on the front control panel.



Connect your computer



Connect a computer to your display using an HDMI cable and, to enable touch, a USB cable.

You can also use a single USB-C cable to connect a computer for both video and touch.

Interact with the computer's desktop

After connecting a computer, press the Input Select button → on the front control panel, then tap the computer's thumbnail.

Sign in

Sign in to your SMART Account on the display so you can personalize settings. If your account is connected to an active SMART Notebook Plus or Lumio account, you can also sync your lesson files, download files from Google Drive or OneDrive, and more.

To sign in, tap in the display's upper left.



Write and erase

Pick up one of the display's pens and write or draw in digital ink. To erase, move your fist or palm over the ink.

Use the iQ features

The display's iQ features are available without connecting a computer. Tap the Home button \bigcirc to access iQ features.
